

We are proud of our new old bridge!

Then referred to as *Pulaski County* #15, it was originally installed in 1913 over the Monon Creek in Pulaski County, IN. This iron truss structure has been re-born in Hendricks County at McCloud Nature Park..and we think it's #1! The bridge spans 120 feet across Big Walnut Creek with the help of a new concrete causeway stretching the additional 230 feet. This is the first time access to the north side has been available which almost doubles the size of McCloud. Our bridge has been fully restored since its disassembly in 2006 and will proudly live in our park for another lifetime. See a piece of history!
