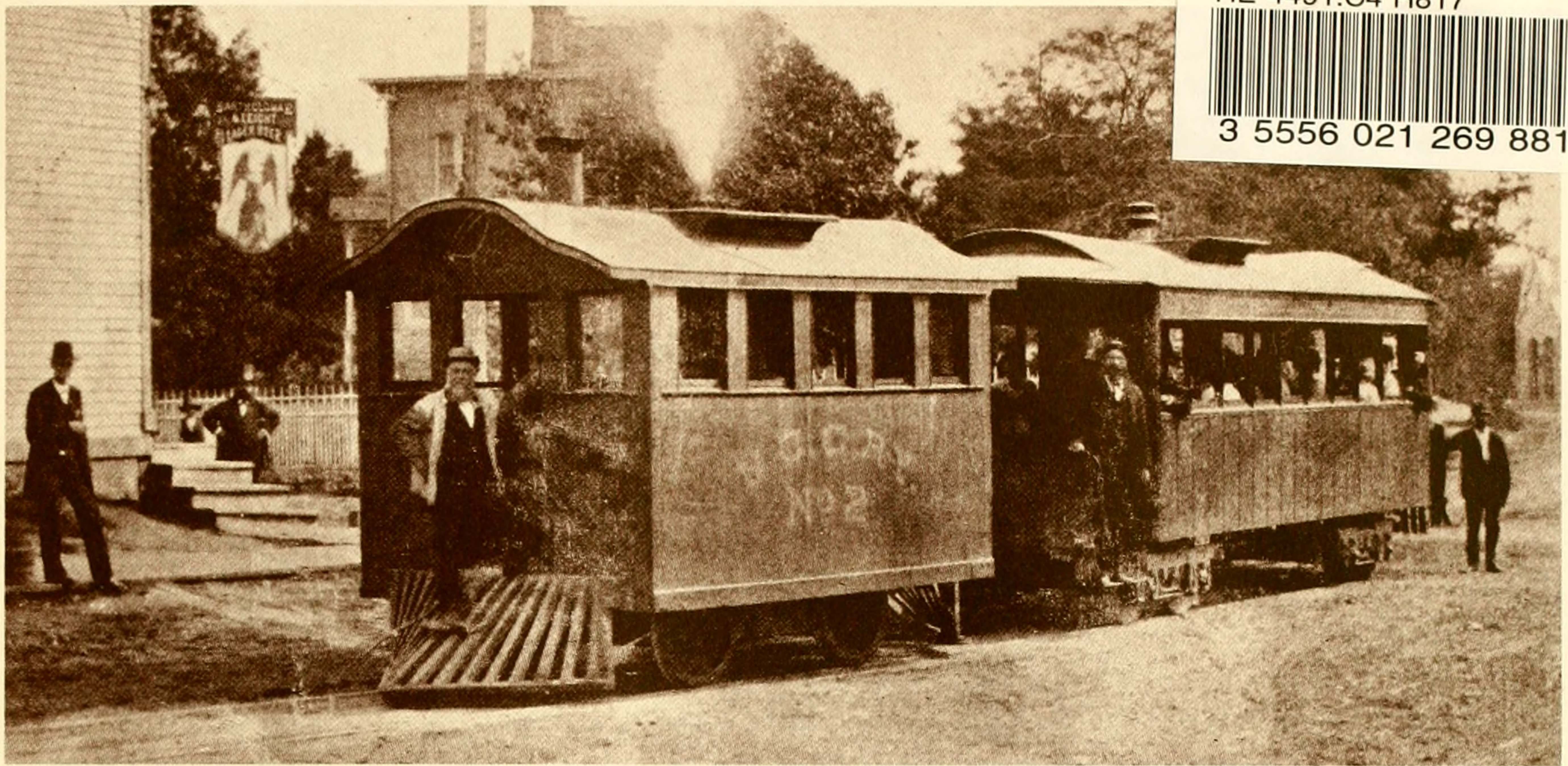

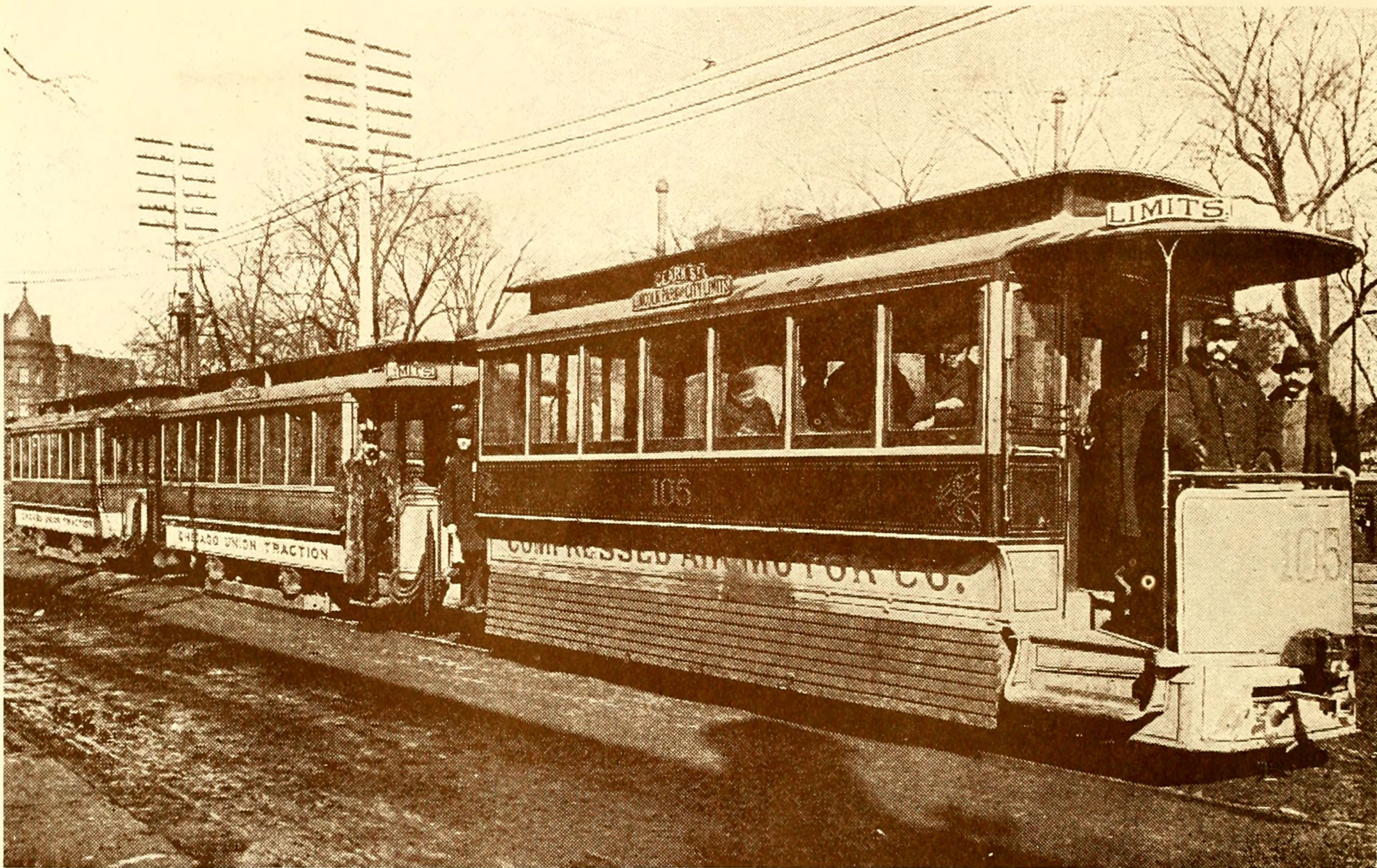

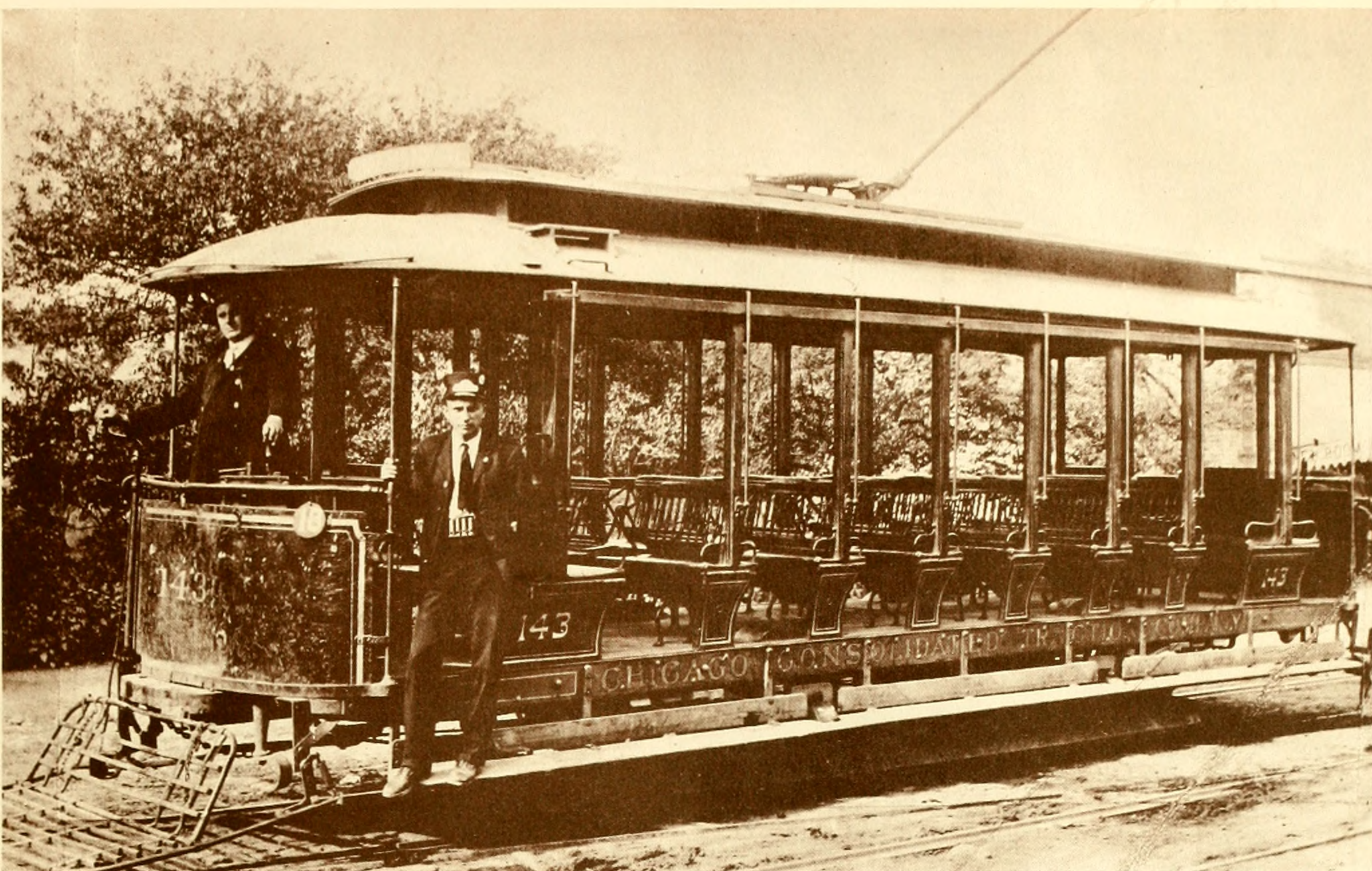

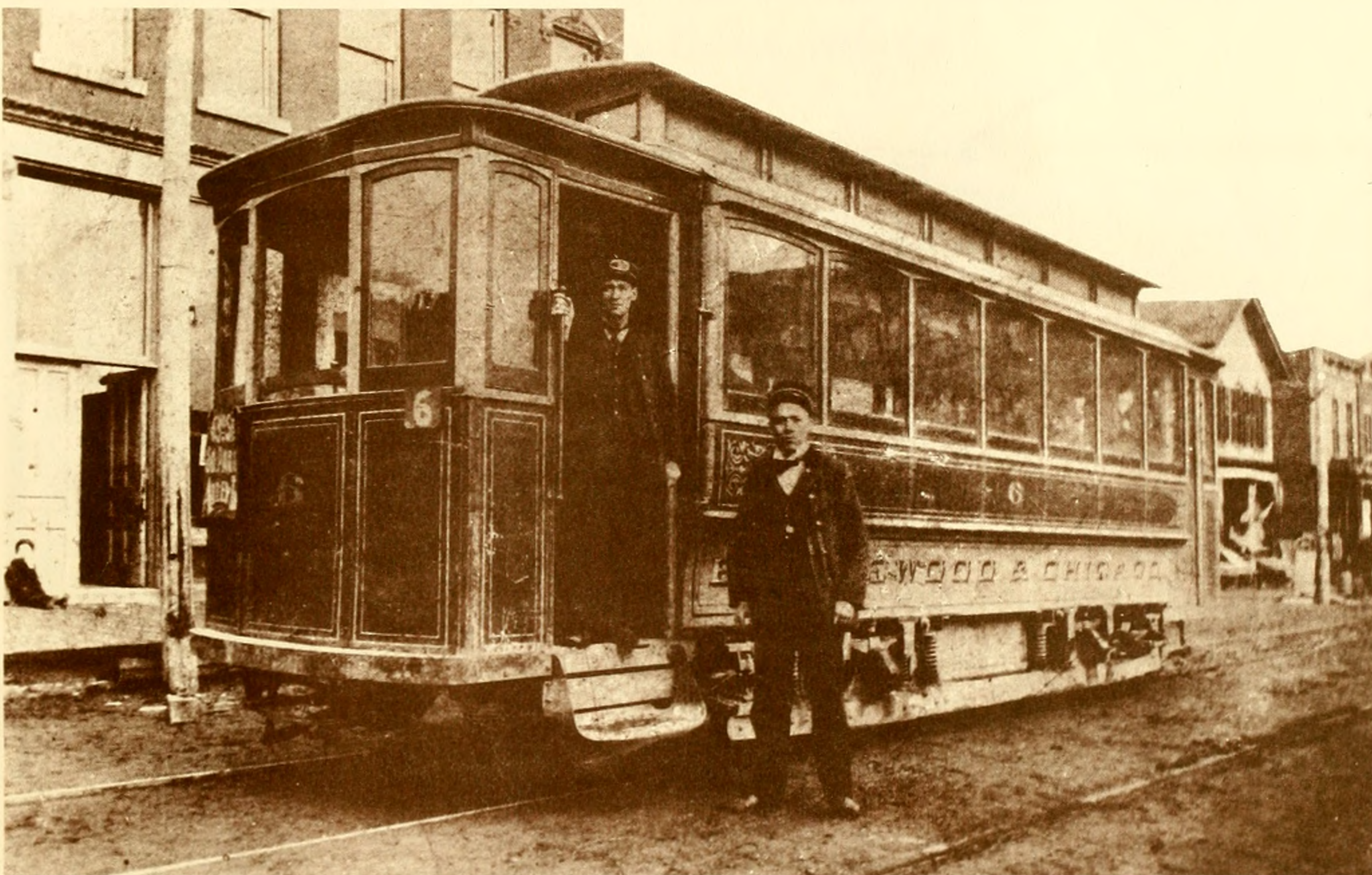

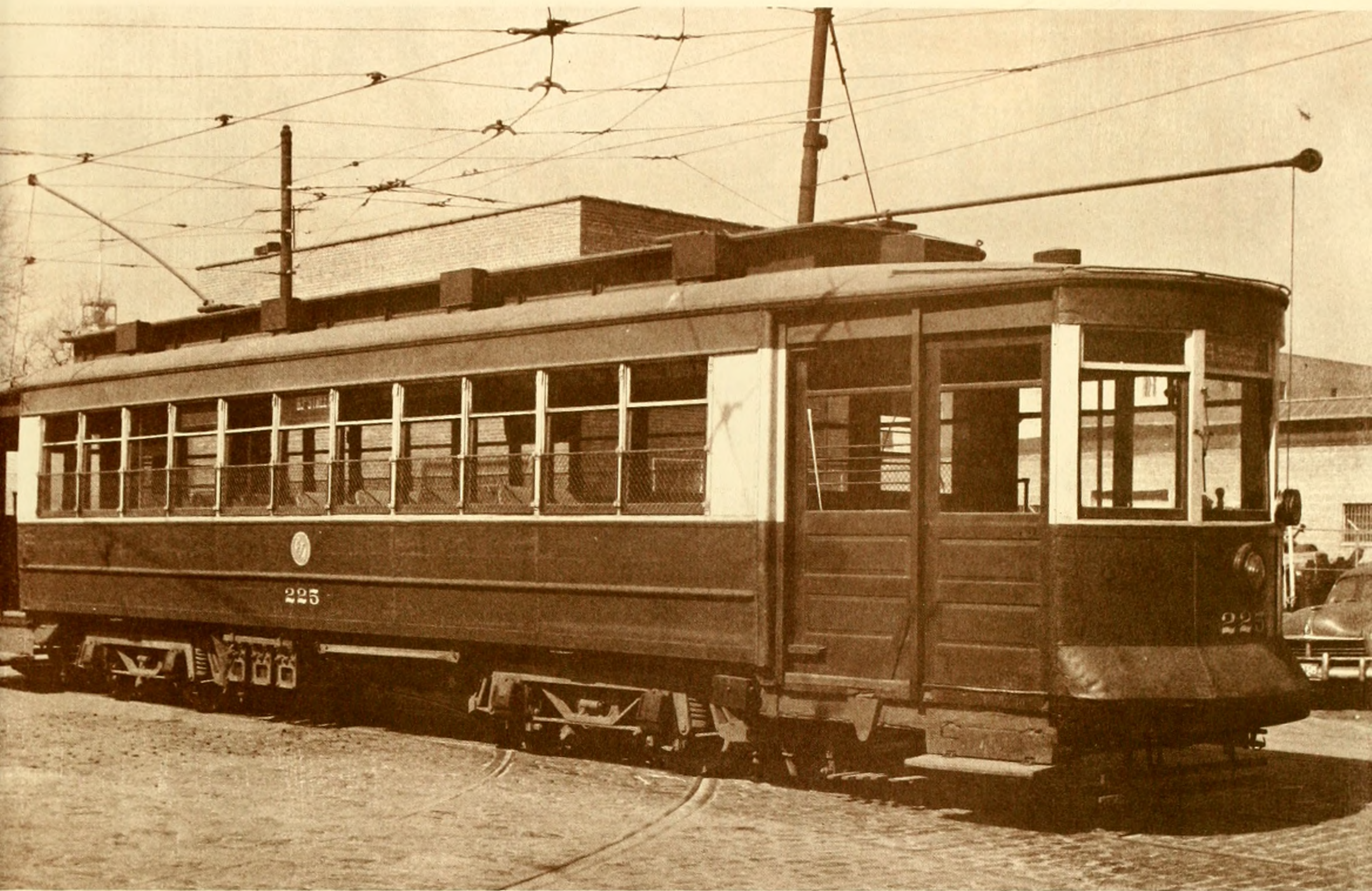

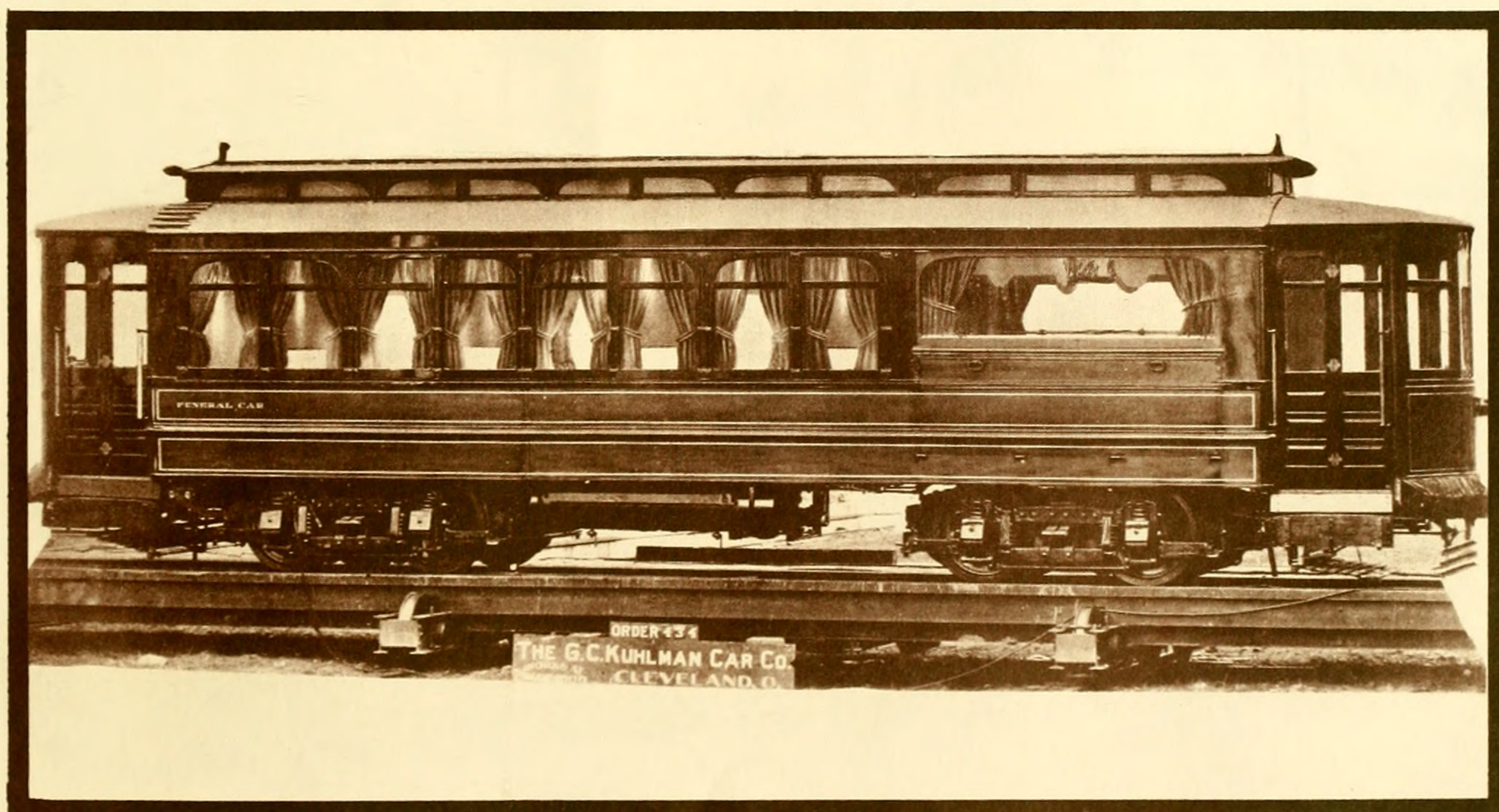

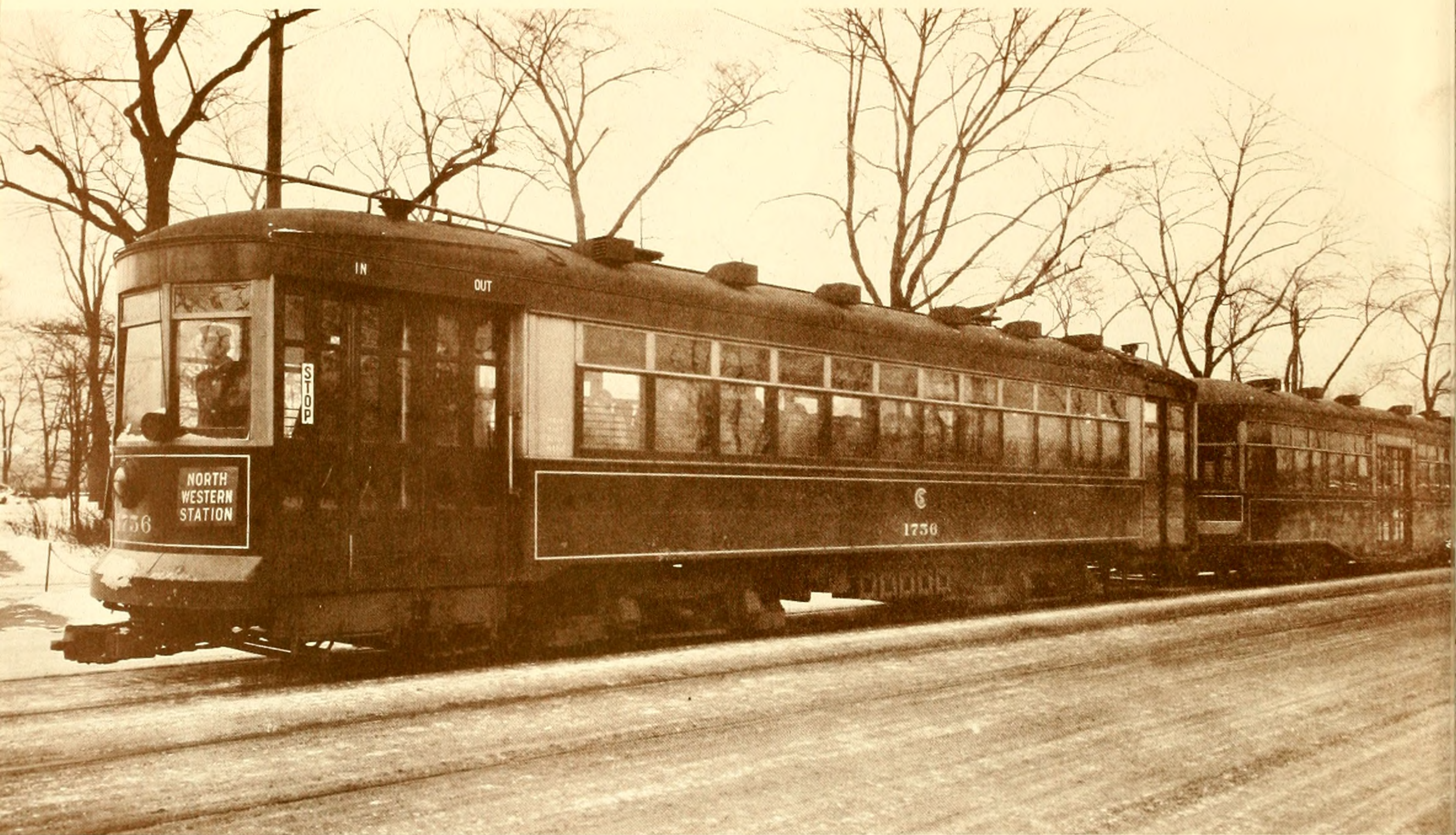

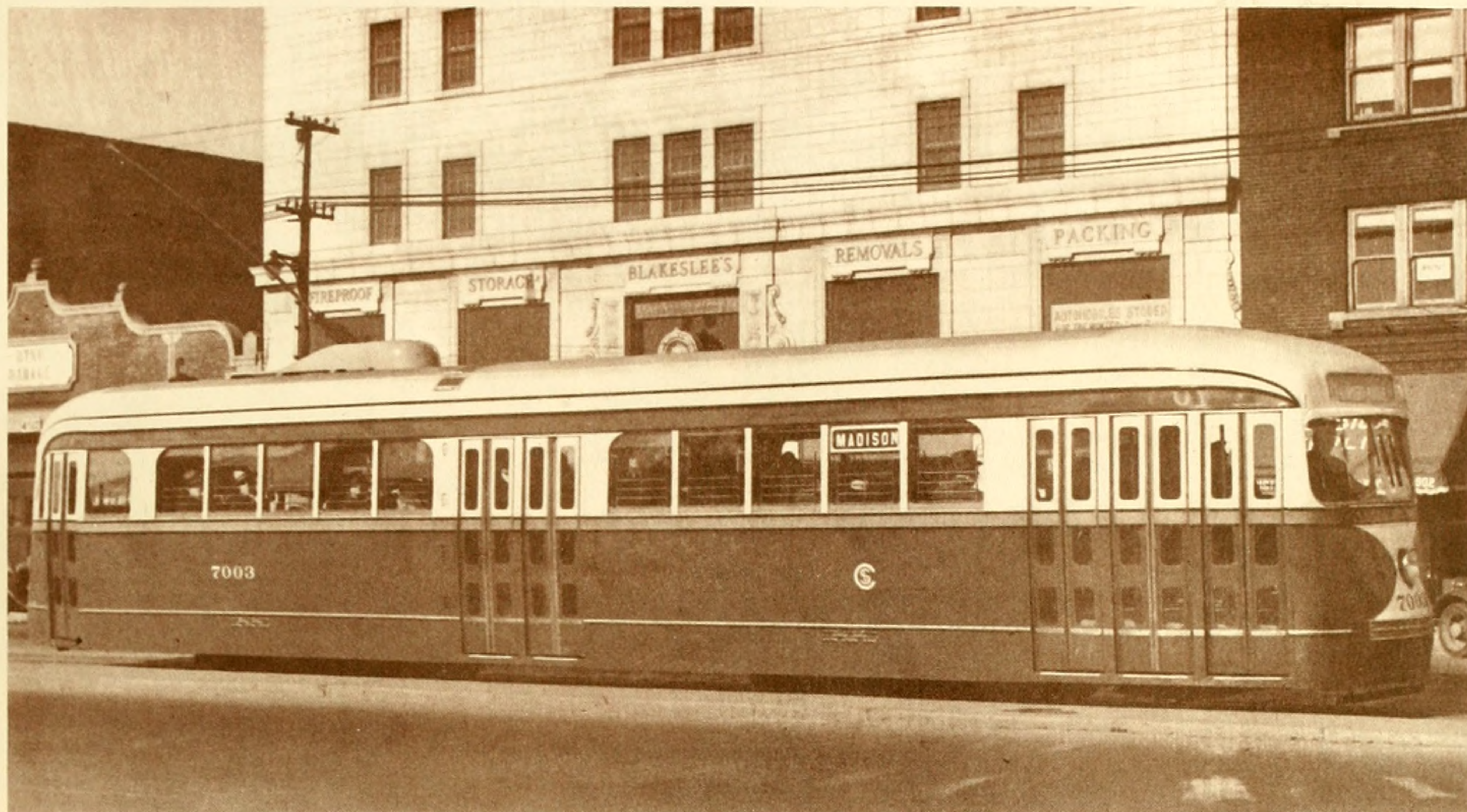

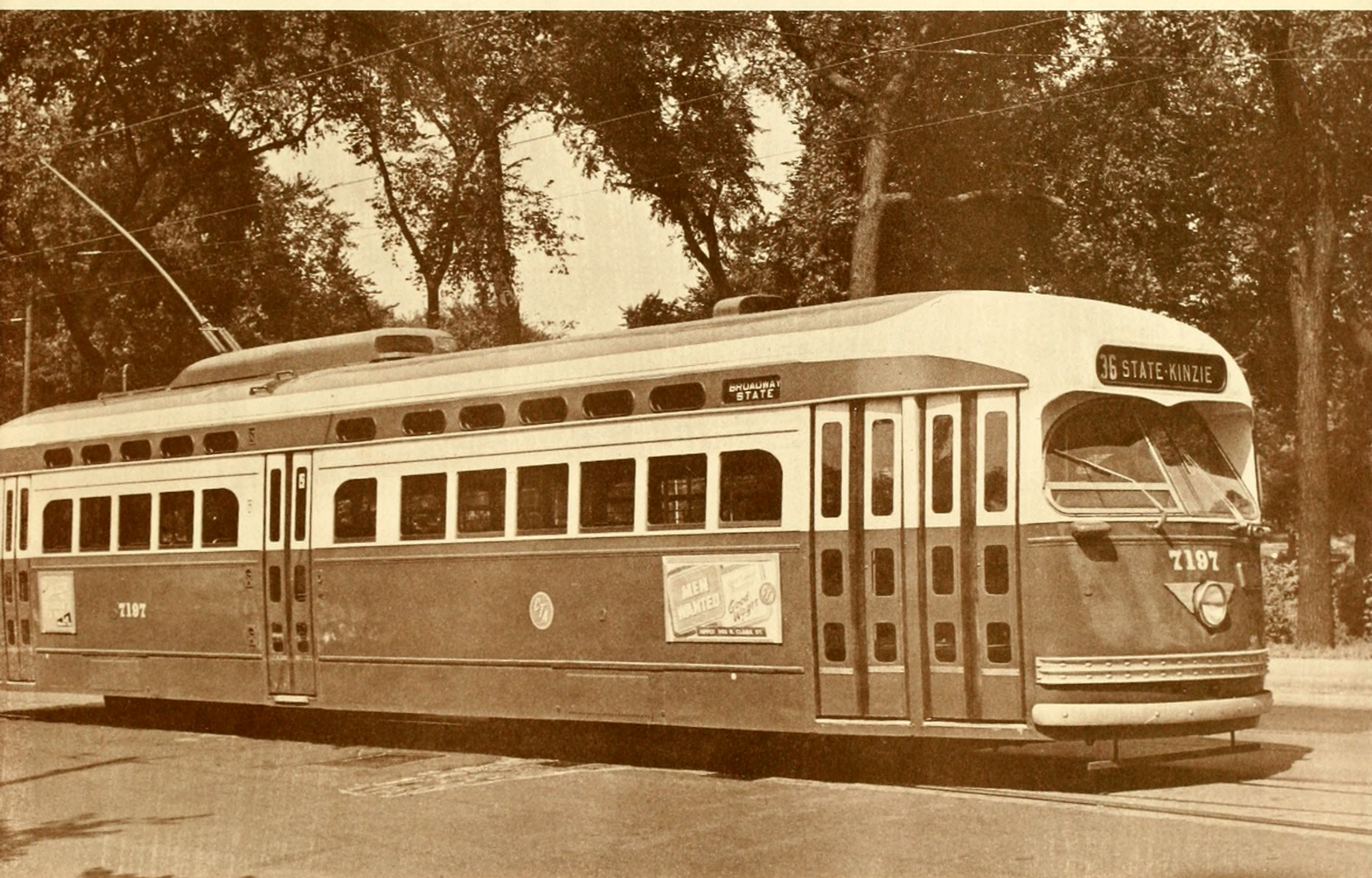

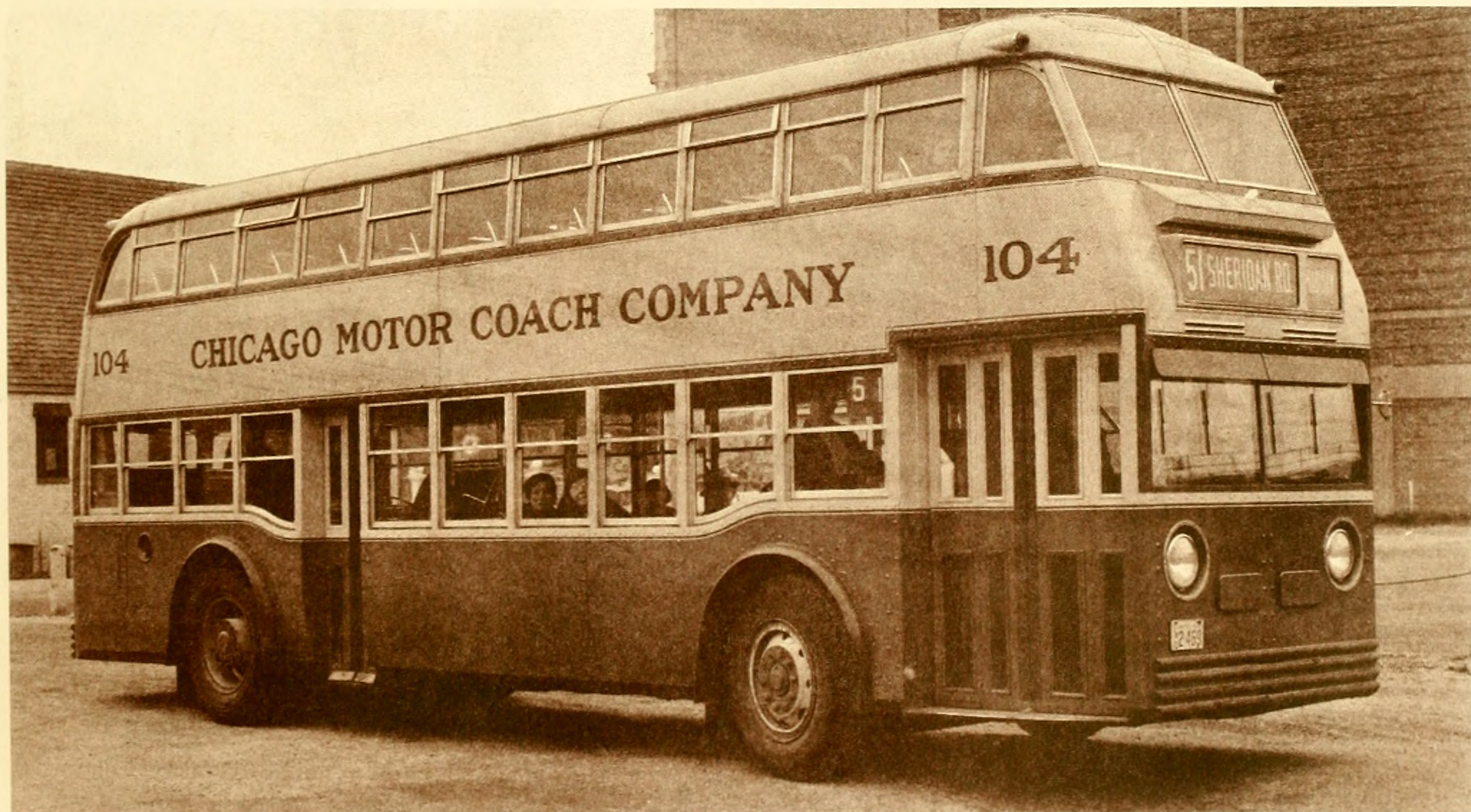

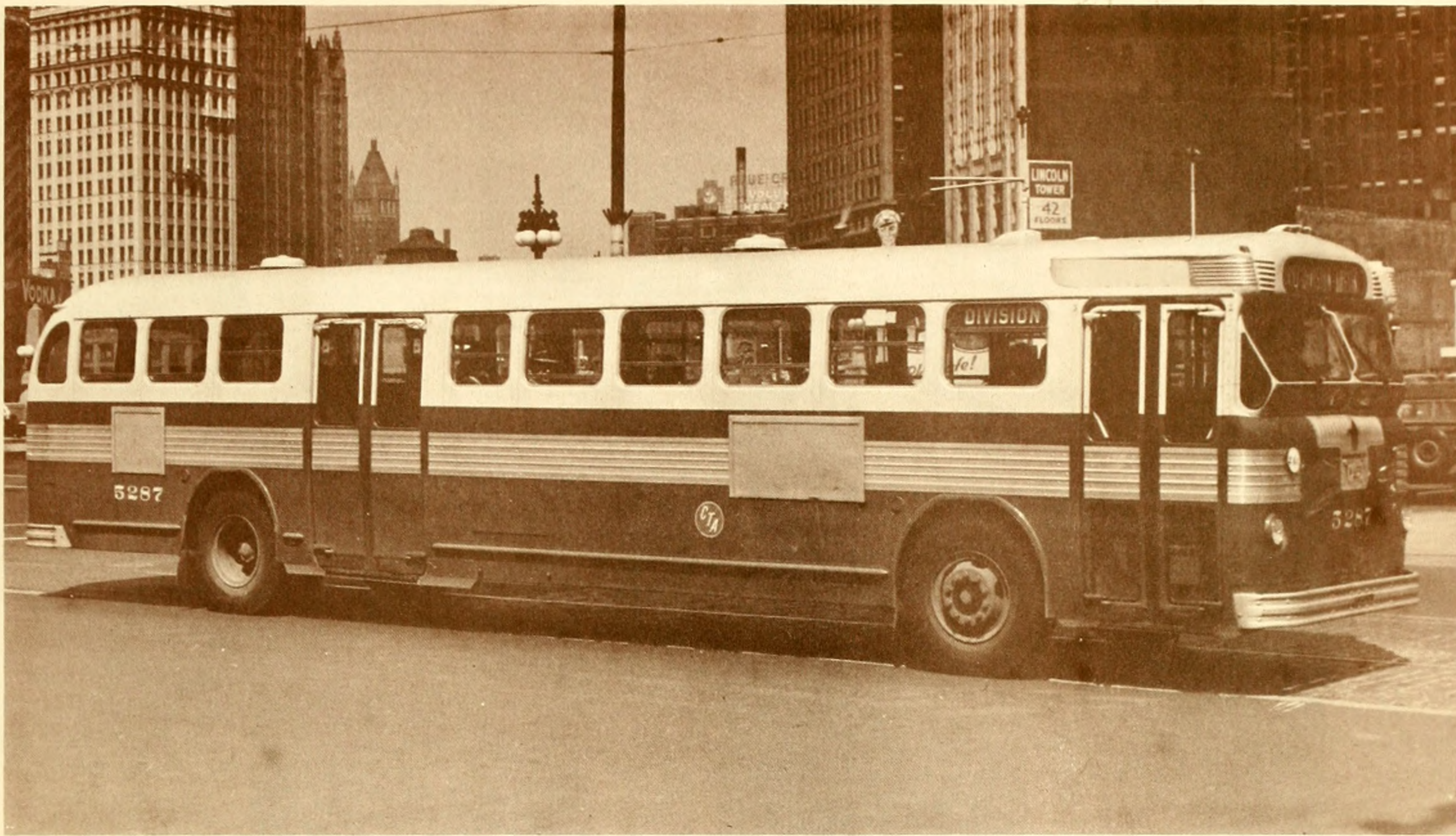

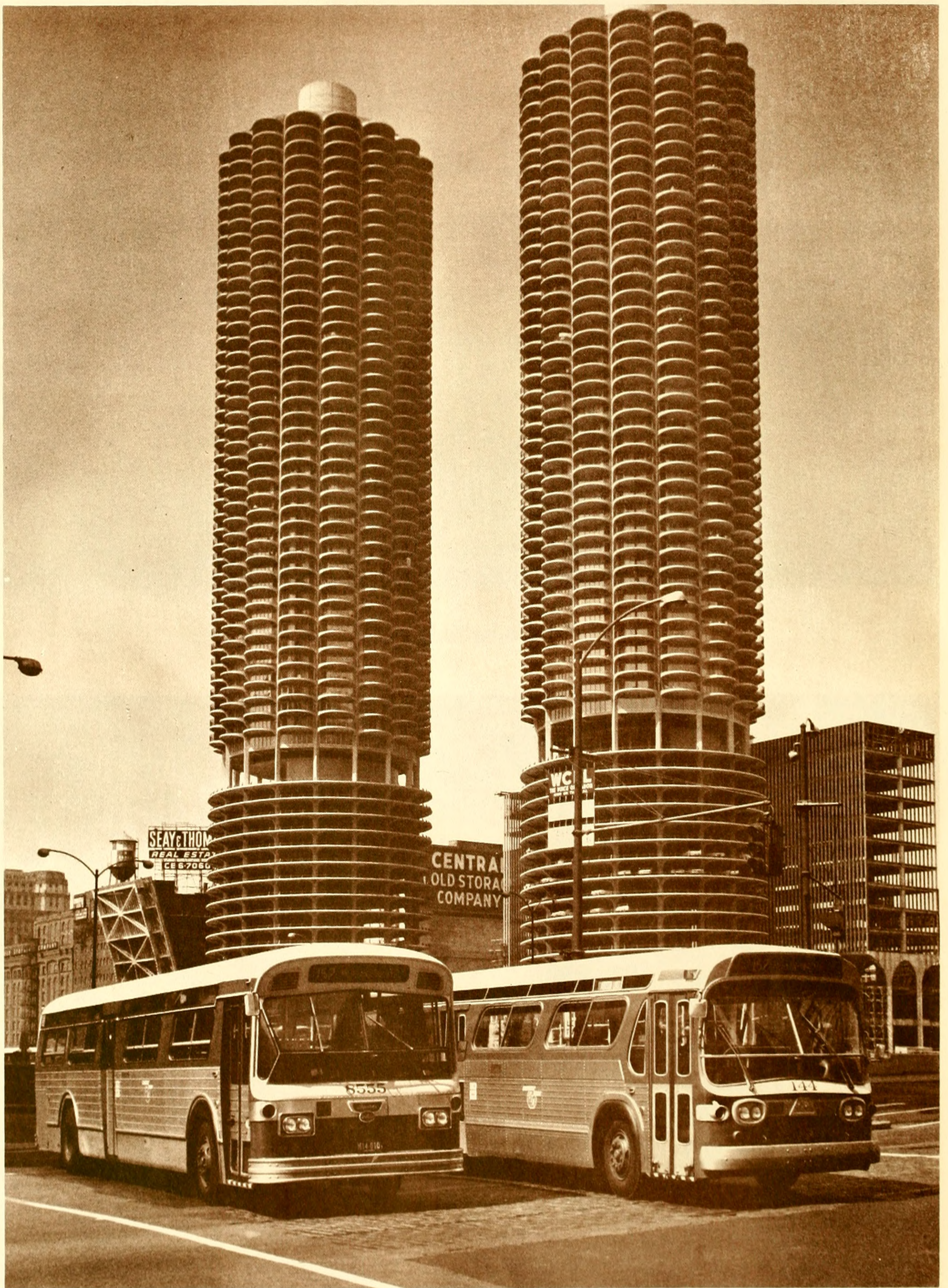

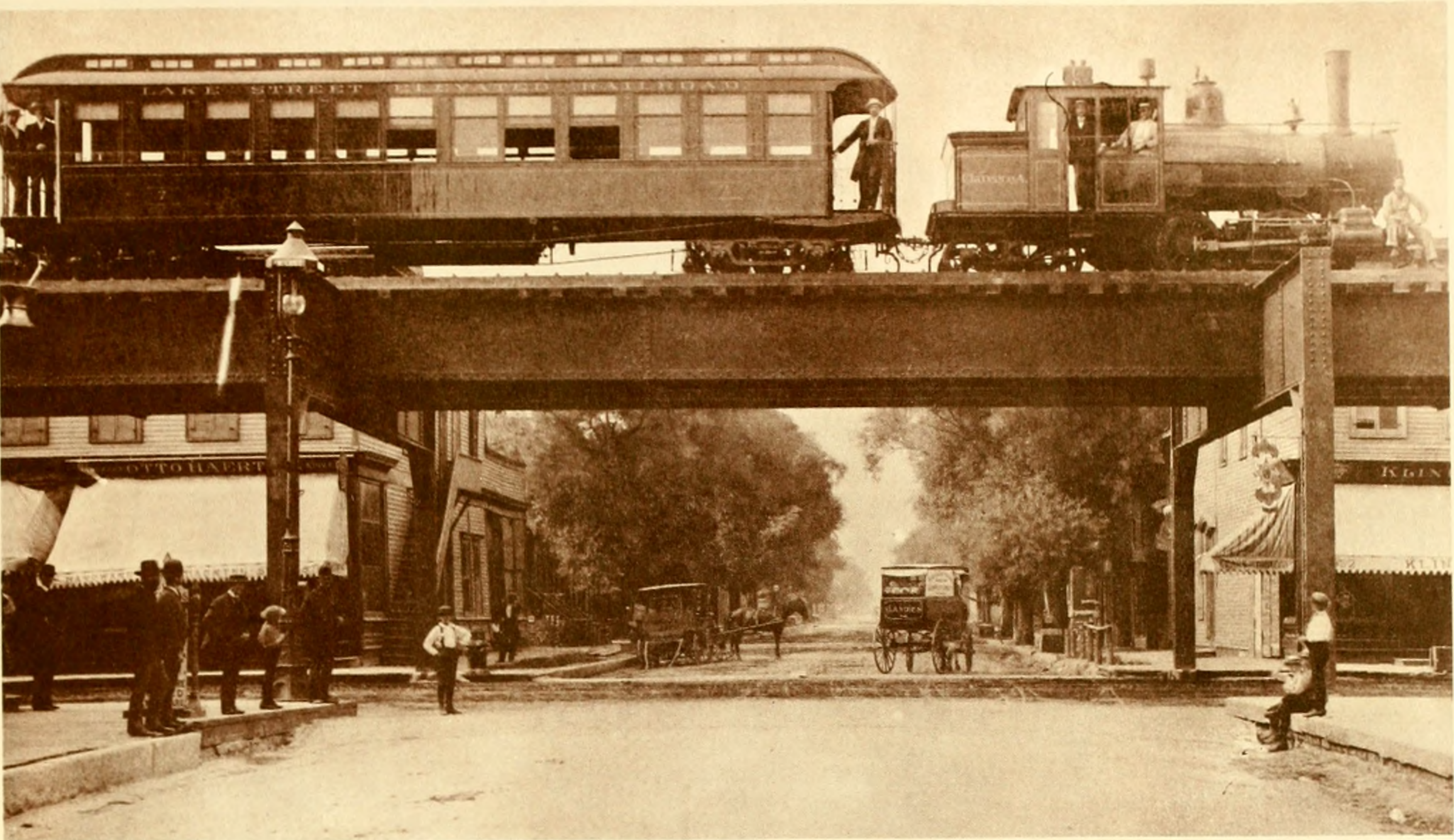

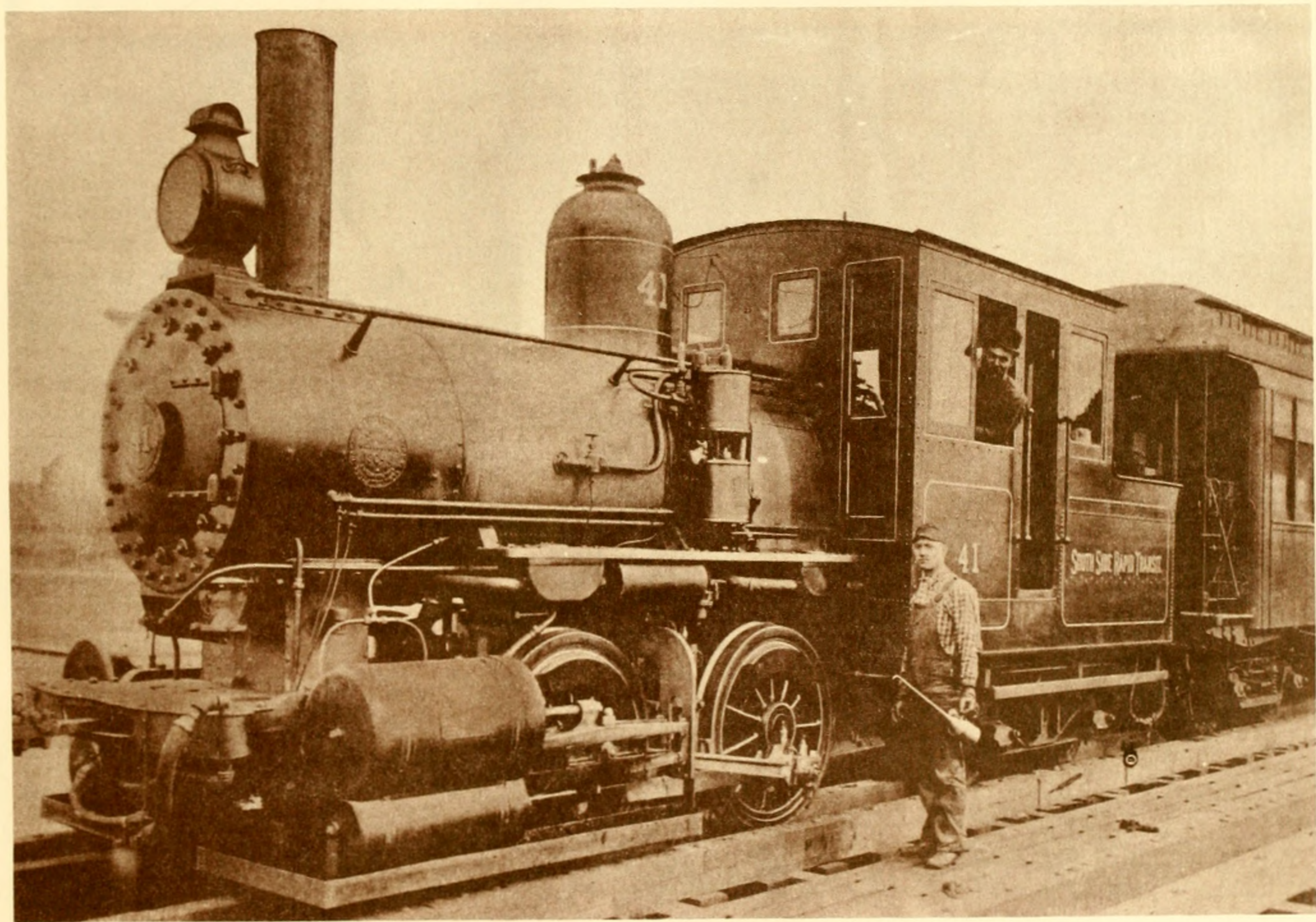

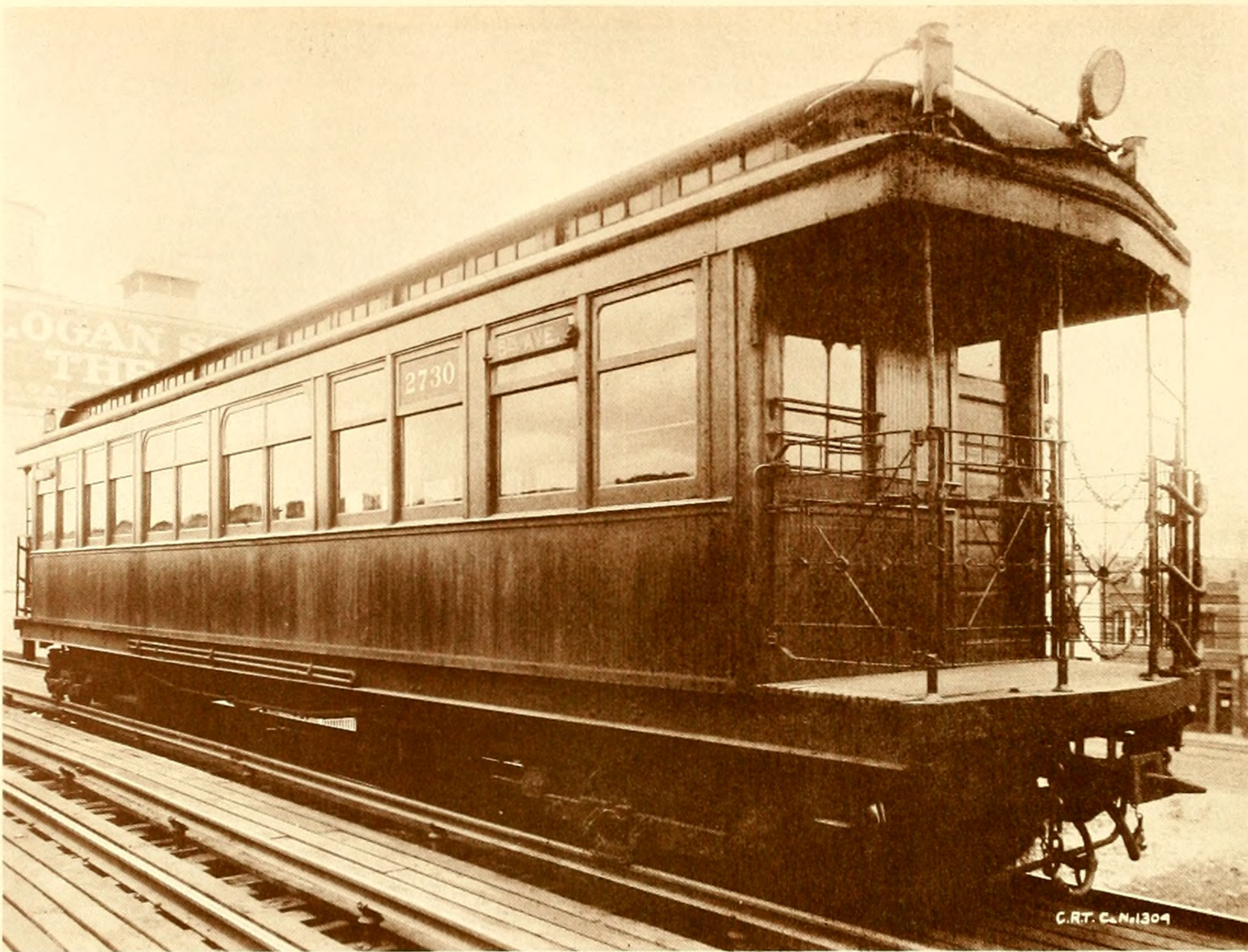

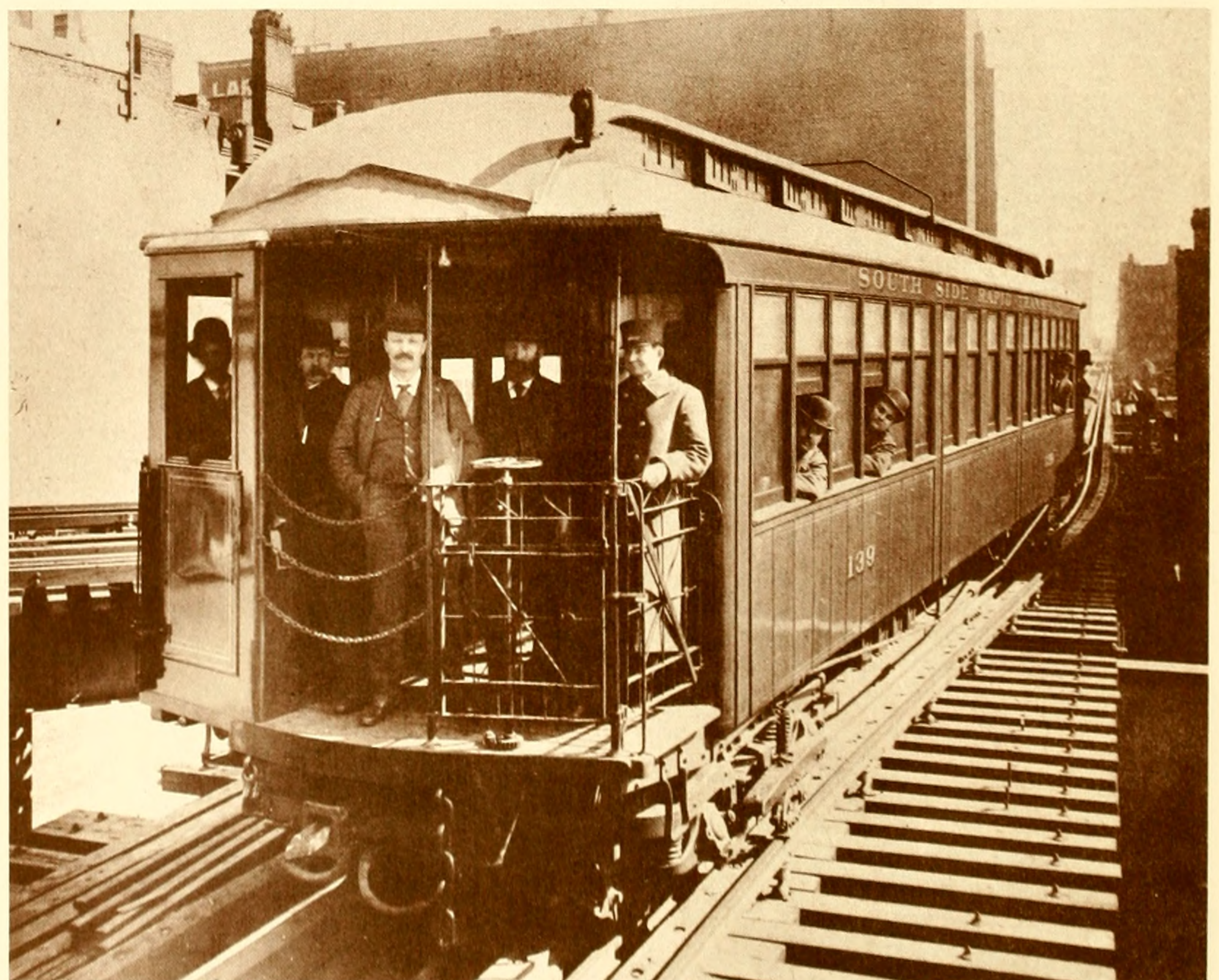

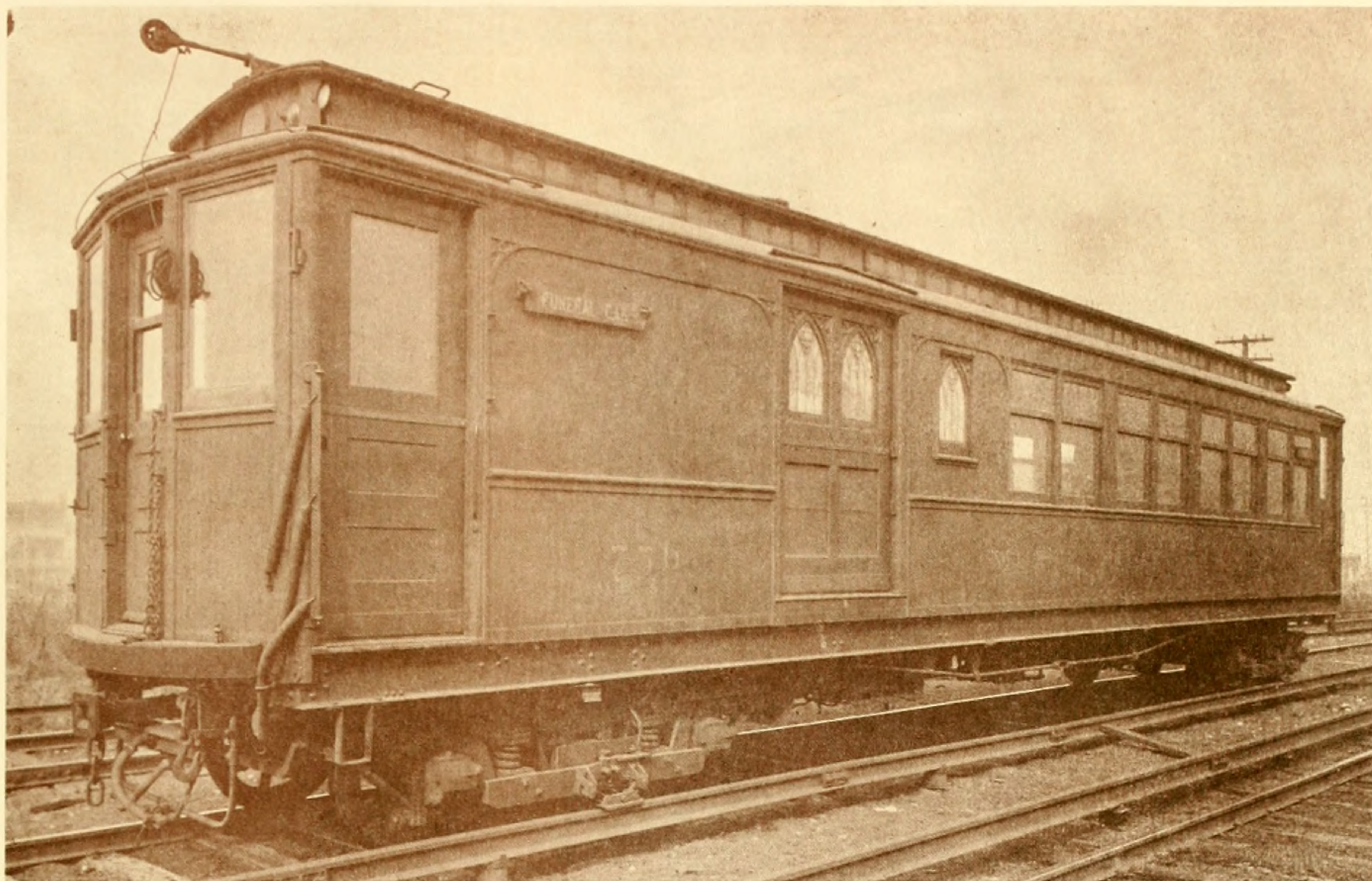

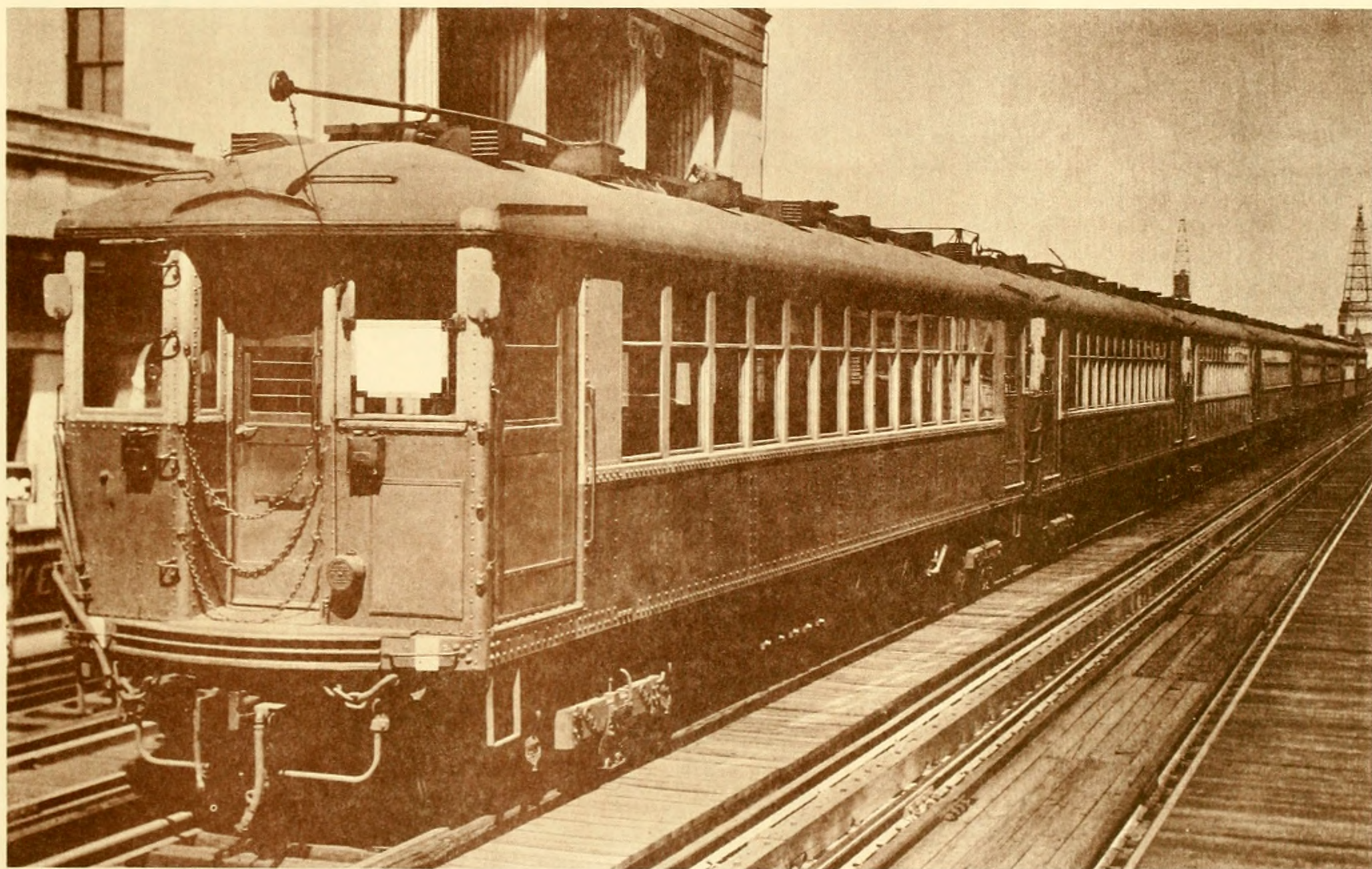
Wood-steel car -- first type of electric motor car (1895-1955)



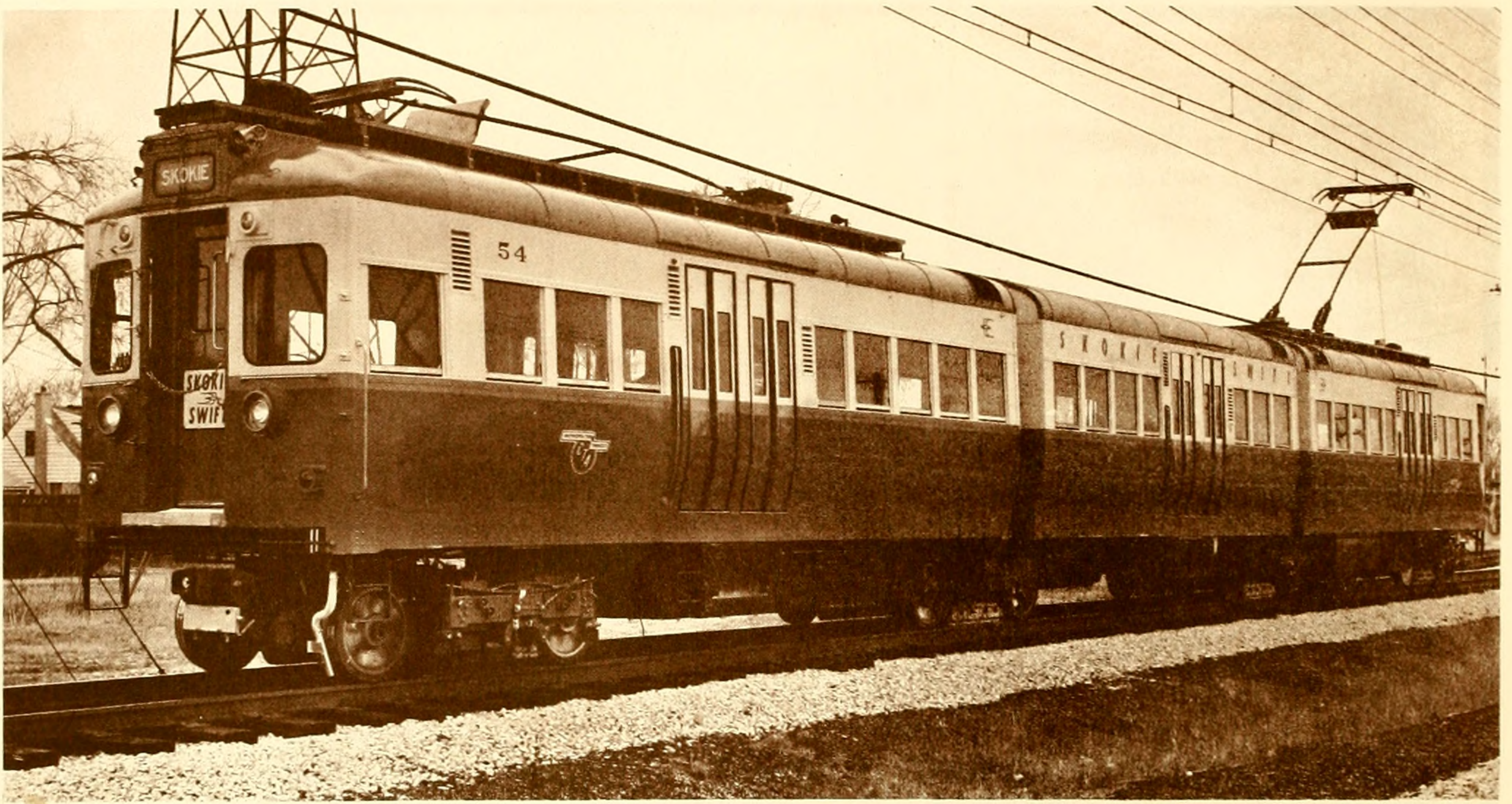
Wood-steel car -- first type of multiple-unit electric car (1898-1937)

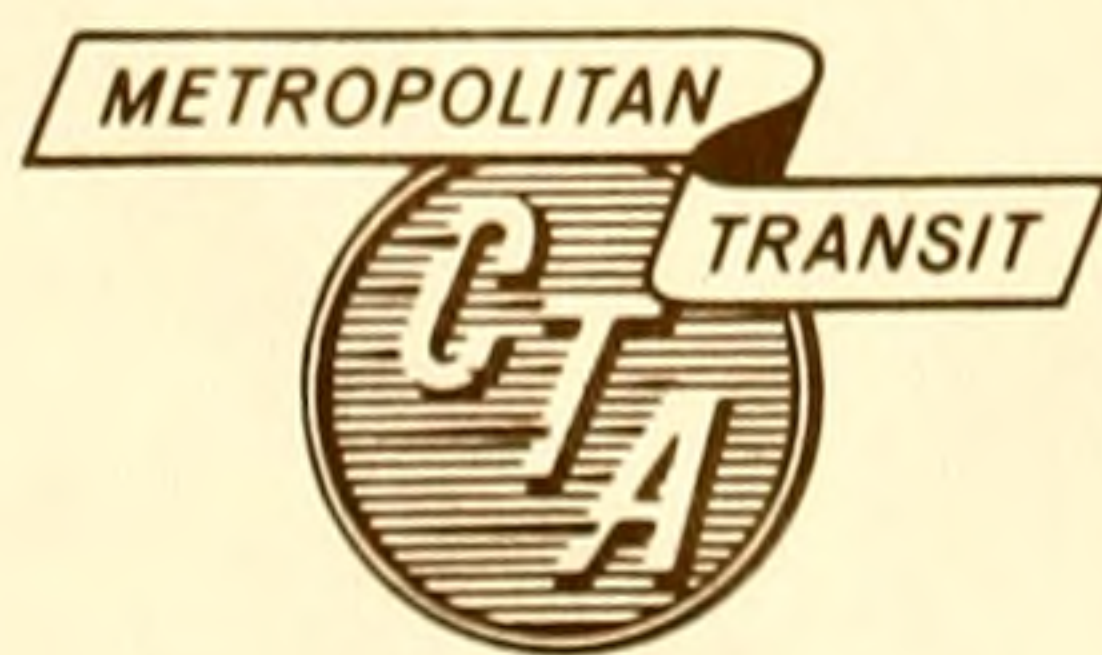
